TOTAL RESOURCE AUCTIONS ADDS CALIFORNIA, MISSOURI AND NEBRASKA LOCATIONS *Total Resource Auctions Services Now Available at 35 Locations*

ATLANTA – The Total Resource Auctions network of salvage wholesale auctions has expanded to 35 locations nationwide with the addition of three new operating locations in Fontana, Calif., Kansas City, Mo., and Omaha, Neb.
