**MANHEIM'S TOTAL RESOURCE AUCTIONS EXPANDS TEXAS PRESENCE

Second, it reinforces our commitment to expand our salvage operations. And third, it means adding experienced and knowledgeable leaders to our team, which is great news for us, for our customers, and for the industry.”

Estes said he feels fortunate to join a company with the growth potential of Total Resource Auctions.

“After running Central Cities Auction Pool for more than 20 years independently, it's exciting to join forces with Total Resource Auctions,” Estes said. “This is a company that is on the move, continually looking for new ways to better serve its customers through technology enhancements, great customer service, and a commitment to continued growth. I'm proud to be a part of that.”

The acquisition of Central Cities Auction Pool comes on the heels of an earlier expansion for Total Resource Auctions this spring; in March, the company announced the
